

# Sewing & Needle Case



**Make a Keepsake to keep your needles, pins and scissors in.**

**This makes a wonderful gift for just about anyone.**

**The heart is stitched on black glitter felt, and when all finished I added a few little sparkles to it to add just a bit of BLING!**

Sew out the heart design on black sparkle felt. Cut matching back. Using a decorative scissors makes a fun border. Make a paper pattern of the heart design and cut on the fold a black set and how ever many white sets that you want for "pages". The white should be just a bit smaller in size.



Open the black heart that was cut on the fold, this is the lining for the front and back. Using Fabri Tack glue, glue a satin ribbon down the center point of the front heart, across over the connected arm and out the bottom back point. Leave dry. Add the embroidery to the front and matching cut to the back, covering the ribbon in-between the "sandwich".

Open the white hearts and using the machine, straight stitch them to the black liner at the fold part. Now add a slit on one page for your tiny heirloom scissors, and add pins and needles. Felt is great for writing the needle size on with a Sharpe as well so this is great for keeping different size embroidery machine needles in.



Your completed project makes a wonderful addition to your sewing room. Or give it to a special friend to keep as a treasured heirloom.
