

Technological Shirt Protector



Make those new parents smile with this little bit of protection and a funny direction sheet. Perfect for baby showers, or hospital gifts.

You will need a pre-fold diaper. I am using the Gerber colored ones, but you can use white or use dye to color them. You will also need Floriani stitch and tear, and trim.



Embroider your design on the diaper. Usually making the bottom of the design about 3 inches from the bottom of the diaper depending on what kind of trim you are using. You want it to be near the bottom and away from baby's face.



Use decorative trims to finish the bottom. You can also add a piece of flannel to the front right sides together then sew around leaving a small opening to turn and stitch for a finished back!

It might be fun to add a little instruction sheet for the new parents. Something cute and eye catching like:

Technological Shirt Protector

Instructions for Use

1. Place this cloth over your shoulder, with design part on your back facing up.
2. Gently pick up baby and put topside of baby over shoulder with face side pointing over shoulder.
3. Pat back side of baby gently till noise or something else comes out of top end, being careful for any action on lower end.
